CONSERVATION MEASURE 209/XIX^{1,2} Exploratory Longline Fishery for *Dissostichus eleginoides*in Statistical Subarea 58.6 in the 2000/01 Season

The Commission hereby adopts the following conservation measure in accordance with Conservation Measure 65/XII:

- Fishing for *Dissostichus eleginoides* in Statistical Subarea 58.6 shall be limited to the exploratory longline fishery by Argentina, France and South Africa. The fishery shall be conducted by Argentinian, French and South African-flagged vessels using longlining only. No more than one vessel per country shall fish at any one time.
- The precautionary catch limit for this exploratory fishery in Statistical Subarea 58.6 shall be limited to 450 tonnes of *Dissostichus eleginoides*, to be taken by longlining. In the event that this limit is reached, the fishery shall be closed.
 - For the purpose of this exploratory longline fishery, the 2000/01 fishing season is defined as the period from 1 May to 31 August 2001.
- The exploratory longline fishery for the above species shall be carried out in accordance with Conservation Measures 29/XIX and 200/XIX.
